Post Surgical Instructions & Prescription Information

- -Please keep your incisions clean, dry, & covered. Do not get it wet in the shower! Paint incision with half strength peroxide if needed when changing saturated dressings after **5 days** post-op followed by waterproof bandages and compression. *No Neosporin, Vitamin E, or Scar Cream.* If in a brace, remove brace and replace after.
- -Apply ice 20 minutes of every hour (while awake) for the first 48 hours, then as needed for swelling. Do not put directly on the skin. No Heat!
- -You received Antibiotics through your IV while you were here, but we do not routinely prescribe antibiotics post operatively. If so, it will be specified.
- -Most pain medicine contains Tylenol; please do not take Tylenol (acetaminophen) with your pain medicine.
- -No pain medicine will be called in after hours (5 PM) or on the weekend! Please call our PRESCRIPTION LINE for prescription changes or refill requests. Prescription Line: (828)258-8800 ext 3700

Common Post-Op Prescriptions: You may receive some or all of these depending on the procedure you have done.

Pain Medication: Percocet (Oxycodone) or Norco (Hydrocodone) – take per instructions as needed for pain; usually a good idea to take as written

Anti-Nausea: Phenergan (promethazine) or Zofran (ondansetron) ODT – take per instructions as needed for nausea

Stool Softener: Colace (docusate) - take per instructions on days when narcotic pain meds needed. *Constipation not a matter of 'if' but 'how much'*.

Muscle Relaxer: Robaxin (methocarbamol) – take per instructions as needed for muscle spasm/tightness

Anti-Inflammatory: Mobic (Meloxicam) – take for 14 days post-op once daily; this will not be

HIP SURGERY PATIENTS - Take as directed for 6 weeks post-op

DVT Prophylaxis: Aspirin 325 mg to be taken once daily x 30 days unless prescribed otherwise
